	What will my teachers do?	What do I need to do?
When will work be set?	Work will be set weekly over Google classroom. Pupils who do not have access have their vocabulary knowledge organisers to use.	Check Google classroom either on the day that you have your French lesson or first thing Monday morning – by 9am. Your teacher may set you individual class work or work for a week.
How will work be set?	Via google classroom/paper copies	Check regularly Google classroom for instructions/work set.
What work will be covered until Easter?	<p>There will be a range of revision activities as well as new content that students will be expected to 'flip learn'.</p> <p>KS3 – Students will continue with the current unit they are studying – year 7 – 'En famille'. Year 8 'En bonne forme' / 'T'es branché', and year 9 'En vacances'</p> <p>Year 10 – Current unit they are studying – Hometown, neighbourhood and region. Pupils then to study new topic from 'Theme 3' 'Education and Work'. Pupils will also be set a variety of skills based activities i.e. photo cards, role plays and grammar activities.</p>	Check regularly Google classroom for instructions/work set. Check you are able to upload evidence of learning via Google classroom – if not watch a tutorial on youtube showing you how to do this.
What do I do if I am stuck or have a question?	Post your question via private comment on google classroom	Check google classroom for your teacher's response



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What do I do if I don't have access to a computer or the internet?	Pupils have been asked whether or not they have access and those who do not have access have been given paper work	
How can I stay motivated?	Staff will be rewarding hard work through positive referrals and personalised comments. Pupils who are using memrise can compete against other students – prizes will be awarded for the highest scores/time logged on return.
